 - i. On schedule with building. About 80% done. Just need to finish wiring, ceiling, carpet and cabinets.
 - ii. Plan to do a brick garden. Will offer brick purchases within the next month. Purchase online or after masses with personalization.
 - iii. Will have lockers for middle school students. Looking at suppliers to determine availability and quantity needed.
 - iv. Future look may still need to extend use of portables in future years. Also talk of looking at Phase Three (more meeting rooms and possible cafeteria) in another three years or so.

 - i. Still waiting to hear on Prairie Meadows grant but may not know until August now. This is potentially a large grant to help with the building needs.

 - iii. For additional resources, look at moving nurse and counselor to full-time positions. Also classroom furniture as we grow.
 - iv. Other thoughts do we look at obvious things we need now or start to look at what we need for future needs? Possibly School Administrator Management (SAM) person (not an Assistant Principal) that can help take off some of the day-to-day responsibilities that Principal Hade does that are not educational in nature (ex. reports, ordering materials, etc.). Board members to think about and discuss at future meetings.
