# FSA General Meeting April 4, 2022

# 1. Welcome/Call to Order/Order Prayer - 6:32

## 2. Principal Update (Misty Hade)

ISASPs for 3rd-8th grade started today with some technological glitches, but those should be resolved now. Dr. Dan Ryan has met with teachers about regionalization, next steps and to answer any questions. Professional Development will be this Friday with some teachers at Christ the King in the morning and everyone back at St. Luke's in the afternoon. We are currently interviewing and hiring new teachers. Sarah Hazel will be assistant principal/technology teacher starting next fall.

- 3. Treasurer's Report (Matt Edwards) Presented the 2022-2023 budget. Highlights:
  - a. Fundraising: anticipating \$68,500 (increase of \$5,500) now includes Luau as a fundraiser, but amount may need to be tweaked upon meeting with their committee
  - b. Educational needs: increased by \$315 from last year
  - c. Hospitality funds for teacher appreciation, new parent/student ambassadors: increased by \$1150
  - d. Extracurricular: Increased by \$440
  - e. Discounts on spirit wear for new students will be available again this year
  - f. Miscellaneous spending: increased by \$1500
  - g. New building/grounds needs for Phase 2: Now \$5000; planning to reserve \$15000 for future Phase 3 needs
  - h. Added line items for Family Faith; extracurricular activity development; and, library expansion
  - i. \$56,470 anticipated spending for 2022-2023
